gignōskein = to learn, **gnōnai** = to know

gnōsis = knowledge

gnōmōn (ΓΝΩΜΩΝ) = interpreter, pointer

e.g. prognosis, diagnosis, gnomon, gnostic

gonē (ΓΟΝΗ) = offspring, generation, seed

cf. gen-, e.g. gonad, gonorrhea

gōnia = corner or angle, e.g. polygon, pentagon

gony/gonatos = knee (L. = genu), e.g. gonitis

graphein = to inscribe, write, gramma/grammatos

= something written or drawn

e.g. **gram**, **graph**, **grammatical**

gymnos/ē/on = naked, e.g. **gymnasium**, **gymnast**

gynē (ΓΥΝΗ) / **gynaiκος** = woman, e.g. gynecology, androgynous

gyros = circle, e.g. gyrate, gyroscope

haima/haimatos = blood, e.g. anemia, hematoma.

hyperglycemia, ischemia, hematology

hairein = to take, e.g. dieresis, catheresis

hals/halos = salt (cf. L sal), e.g. halogen, haloid

haptein = to fasten, **hapsis** = joining, e.g. synapsis

hēbē = time of youth or puberty, **ephebe** = youth

hedra = seat, base . . . side, e.g. polyhedron, tetrahedron

hēdonē (HΔONH) = pleasure, e.g. hedonism

hēlios = sun, helium, heliocentric

helix/helikos = coil, e.g. helix, helicopter

helmins/helminthos = worm, e.g. helminthiasis

hēmera = day, e.g. ephemeral

henai = **hienai** = to let go, to send, e.g. enema, catheter

hēpar/hēpatos = liver, e.g. hepatitis

herpein = to creep (L. serpere), e.g. herpes

heteros/a/on = one or the other of 2, different (opp. **homos/homoios**)

e.g. heterogenous, heterosexual

hieron = sacred, e.g. hieroglyphics

hippos = horse, e.g. Philip(pa), hippopotamos

histos = mast, beam, then web & tissue, e.g. histology

hodos = way or road, e.g. exodus, period, odometer

holos = all, e.g. whole, holograph, holistic, holocaust

homalos = even, e.g. anomaly

homos/homoios = like or equal, e.g. homosexual, homogenize
(cf. L homo = human being in homicide)

hormaein = to set in motion, hormon = present participle
e.g. hormone, hormonogenic

hydōr, hydatos = water, hygros = wet
e.g. hydrogen, hydrodynamics, hydrophobia,
dehydrate, hydrostatics, hygrometer

hygieia = health, e.g. hygiene

hymēn = thick skin, membrane, e.g. hymen, Hymenoptera

hypnos = sleep, e.g. hypnotize, hypnotic

hystera = womb, e.g. hysterectomy
