**ponere/positum** = put, e.g. com- de- dis- ex-  
im- inter- op- pro- re- sup- trans- pose -position, postpone,  
component, exponent, posture, -positor

**pons/pontis** = bridge, e.g. pons (anat. & dent.),  
pontifex maximus, pontificate

**porta** = gate, e.g. port, portal, portico

**portare/portatum** = to carry (cf. ferre, gerere)  
e.g. de- ex- im- re- sup- trans- port, portable

**potare/potatum** = drink, e.g. potable, potion

**posse** = to be able, **potens/potentis** = present participle  
e.g. potent, impotence, potential

**premere/pressum** = press, e.g. com- de- re- sup- press,  
pressure, compressor, decompression

**proles/prolis** = offspring, e.g. prolific, proliferate

**propria/us/um** = one's own, e.g. proper, propriety,  
proprietor, property

**pubes/puberis** = young adult, e.g. pubes, puberty, pubescent

**pulmo/pulminis** = lung, e.g. pulmonary (cf. GK pneumon)

**pungere/punctum** = to prick, e.g. pungent, acupuncture,  
punctuate, punctual

**pupa** = doll, dimin. pupilla, e.g. puppet, puppy, pupil

**pus/puris** = pus, e.g. pus, purulence, dimin. pustula

**\*putare/putatum** = to reckon, to think, e.g. compute, reputation

**quadrare/quadratum** = to square— see quattuor, quartus p 83,  
e.g. quadrant, quadratic

**\*quantum (-a or -us)** = how much (+ tantum = so much), e.g. quantum mechanics, quantity, quantify (cf. quality from Lat qualis = what kind)

**rabere** = to rage, rabida/us/um, noun rabies, e.g. rabid

**radere/rasum** = to scrape, rasura = erasure,  
e.g. abrade, erase, corrasible

**radius** = rod/spoke/ray, e.g. radium, radiation, radial

**radix/radicis** = root, e.g. radix, radical, eradicate

**regere/rectum** = to guide, keep straight, recta/us/um = straight

**rex** = king, **regina** = queen, e.g. rectum, erection, regimen, regiment

**ren/renis** = kidney, e.g. renal, adrenalin

**repere/reptum** = to creep, e.g. reptile

**rete/retis** = net, e.g. retina, reticulate(d)

**rigor** = stiffness, e.g. rigo(u)r, rigid, rigor mortis

**rodere/rosum** = to gnaw, e.g. rodent, corrosive, erosion

**rosa** = rose (GK rhodon p 208), e.g. rosacea (< -acea p80 #3)

**rota** = wheel, rotare/rotatum, e.g. rotor, rotate

**ruber/rubra/rubrum** = red, e.g. bilirubin, rubella, ruby

**rugia** = wrinkle, e.g. corrugate

**rumpere/ruptum** = to burst, e.g. eruption, rupture, interrupt

**saccus** = sac, e.g. sac, sack

**sacer/sacra/sacrum** = sacred, e.g. os sacrum, sacro-

**saepire/saeptum** = enclose, e.g. septum = partition, transept

**sal/salis** = salt, e.g. saline, desalination, salary

**salire/saltum** = to jump, e.g. salient, resilient

**saliva** = saliva

**salus/salutis** = health, salvere = to be well,

**salutare/salutatum** = to greet e.g. salutary, salutation

**sanare/sanatum** = to heal, sanus/a/um = well,

e.g. sane, sanity, sanitation, sanatorium

**sanguis/sanguinis** = blood, e.g. sanguine, sanguinolent
