unda = a wave, e.g. inundate, redundant, undulated

urina = urine, e.g. urinary

uterus = womb, e.g. in utero, uterine

vacca = cow, e.g. vaccine, vaccination

vacuus/a/um = empty, e.g. vacuum, evacuate, horror vacui

vagina = a sheath, e.g. vaginal, invaginate, vaginoabdominal

**valere = to be strong, e.g. valence, equivalent, invalid,
convalescence, prevalence, ambivalent, VALENTINE**

vallis = valley

vallum = a wall, e.g. circumvallate

valva = door, e.g. valve

varia/us/um = diverse or changing, e.g. various, variety, variola

vas = vessel, e.g. vascular

**vehere/vectum = to carry (cf. gerere, ferre),
e.g. vector, vehicle, convex, convection**

vellere/vulsum = to pluck, e.g. convulsion

vena = vein, e.g. intravenous

venenum = poison, e.g. venom

**venire/ventum = to come, e.g. vent, ad-, e-, in-, pre-, subvent,
intervention, eventual, convention, circumvent**

venter/ventris = belly or cavity, e.g. ventricle

Venus/Veneris = goddess of love, e.g. venery, venereal

vergere = to bend, e.g. diverge, convergent

vermis = a worm, e.g. vermicide

**vertere/versum = to turn, vortex = a whirl,
vertebrum (pl vertebra p 77 #40, e.g. vertical, conversion,
convert, pervert, version, diversion, vertebra, transverse**

vesica = the bladder, e.g. vesicle, vesicospinal

via = road, e.g. via, deviation, impervious

vibrare/vibratum = to shake, e.g. vibrate

**videre/visum = to see, e.g. video, veni vidi vici,
vision, visibility, visual, television**

*** vincere/victum = to conquer, e.g. victim, conviction,
vir = a man (male), virtus/virtutis = virtue,
e.g. virile, virtue, virtual**

virus = poison (cf. venenum), e.g. virulent, virus

viscum = birdlime from mistletoe, e.g. viscous

viscus/visceris = internal organs, e.g. viscera, evisceration

vita = life, e.g. vital, vitalize, vitamin, viable

vitrum = glass, e.g. vitreous, in vitro

**vivere/victum = to live, viva/us/um = living
e.g. vivisection, viviparous, vivify**

volare/volatum = to fly, e.g. volatile

**volvere/volutum = to roll, e.g. volute,
evolution, revolve, convolution**

vomere/vomitum = to throw up, e.g. vomit

vorare/voratum = to eat, e.g. devour, carnivorous

**vox/vocis = voice, vocare/vocatum = to call
e.g. vocal, convocation, evocative, provocative**
