NB "insidiae" & other traps: cf. book pp 224–230

16. in- = not (il-l..., im-m..., ir-r...)

(cf GK a-, an- p 135)

e.g. IN-ability, IL-legal, IM-potent, IR-rational

23. non = not, e.g. NON-flammable, NON-conductor

22. juxta = beside, e.g. JUXTA-position

24. ob = in the way, e.g. OB-ject, OB-struct, OB-vious

**25. per = through (pel-l...), e.g. PER se, PER annum,
PERcent, PER-fect, PEL-lucid**

**26. post = after, behind (time or place, cf. ante),
p.m. = post meridiem (post medium diem),
POST mortem, POST-pone, POST-graduate**

**(27.) postero- (posterior) = more behind
(cf. antero-, anterior Prefix #5, above)**

e.g. POSTERO-lateral

28. prae = in front of (pre-)

e.g. PRE-fix, PRE-position, PRE-scribe, PRE-serve

(29.) praeter = more before, past (preter-) e.g. PRÉTER-natural

30. pro = in front of (cf. prae, pre-, & GK pro p 139)

e.g. PRO-position, PRO-scribe, PROs & CONs, PRO-ject

PRO-mote, PRO-mise

31. re- = back, again (derived meaning) (red-)

e.g. RE-flex, RE-act, RED-undant, RED-olent, RE-petition

(32.) **re-tro-** = (more) back

e.g. RETRO-grade, RETRO-fit, RETRO-active, RETRO-spection

33. **se-** = apart (cf. dis- # 12 NOT se of *per se*)

e.g. SE-cretion, SE-gregation, SE-duction

34. **semi-** = half (cf. demi- # 11)

e.g. SEMI-circle, SEMI-PER-meable

< *subs-p* cf. ab / abs

35. **sub** = under (suc-c..., suf-f..., sup-p..., sus-p...)

(cf. GK hypo p 138) e.g. SUB-ject, SUF-fix, SUB-mit, SUS-pense, SUB-stratum, SUB-marine (mare = ??), SUB-script, SUB-atomic

36. **super** = over (cf. sub # 35, GK hyper p 138)

e.g. SUPER-script, SUPER-natural, SUPER-cilious, SUPER-CON-ductivity

(37.) **supra** (cf infra # 17) = above e.g. SUPRA-renal

38. **trans** = across (cf. per # 25 = through)

e.g. TRANS-Canada, TRANS-fusion, TRANS-portation

opposite: **cis**, e.g.
cisatlantic, cisgendered
cis in chemistry
= on this side

39. **ultra** = beyond (cf. infra # 17)

e.g. ULTRA-violet, ULTRA-sound, ULTRA vires
