**bacca** = berry, e.g. baccivorous

**baculum/baculus** = rod, **bacillum/bacillus** = small rod

(p 78 #7 < \*baculillus) — rod-shaped bacterium

cf. GK **bakterion** p 153

**barba** = beard, e.g. barber

**bibere** = drink, e.g. imbibe, bibulous

**bilis** = bile, e.g. bilirubin < **ruber** = red

\*\***bona/bonus/bonum** = good, e.g. bonus, **summum bonum**

**brevis** = short, ENG brief, brevity, abbreviation

**bucca** = cheek, e.g. buccolingual (cf. **os/oris** = mouth)

**bullire/bullitum** = to bubble or boil, **bulla** = bubble, blister

**bursa** GK (p 155) = ox-hide, bag, e.g. bursar

**cadere/casum** — **cid-** = fall, **caducus/a/um** = falling

e.g. coincident, deciduous, casual, cadaver

ENG **case** = event < LAT **casus**, ENG **case** = box < LAT **capsa**

**caecus/a/um** = blind, e.g. **caecum** or **cecum**

**caedere/caesum** — **cid-, cis-** = cut, kill

e.g. incisor, algicide, decision, circumcision, caesura

**calere** = be warm, **calor** = heat (p 77 bot # 5 QCS)

**calory/calorie** (-y < Fr -ie < Lat -ia p 77 # bot QCS)

**callum** = hard skin, e.g. callous

**calx/calcis** = heel, e.g. recalcitrant, calcareous

**calx/calcis** = limestone, e.g. Ca, calculus,

**calculator, calcify**

**canalis** = canal, channel

**cancer/cancri** = crab, e.g. cancer, chancre

**candere** = shine, **candidus** = bright, white

e.g. incandescent, candid, candidate "made white"!

**canis** = dog, e.g. canine

**capere/captum, cip-, cept-** = take

e.g. concept, inception, contraception, receptive,

susceptible, recipe, capable, capacity

**capillus** = hair, e.g. capillary

**capsa** = box, e.g. capsule

**caput/capitis, cep-, cip-** = head

e.g. biceps, decapitation, capital, capitalism

**carbo/carbonis** = coal, e.g. C, bicarbonate

**caries** = decay

**caro/carnis** = flesh, e.g. carnal, incarnation

**cartilago/cartilaginis** = cartilage

**caseus** = cheese, e.g. casein

**catena** = chain, e.g. concatenate

**cauda** = tail, e.g. caudad

**caulis** = stalk, e.g. cauliflower

**cavus/a/um** = hollow, e.g. cave, concave, excavation

**cedere/cessum** = go, e.g. antecedent, abscess,

intercede, accede, success, recess, proceed

**cella** = room, e.g. cellular, cellulose

**cerebrum** = brain, e.g. cerebellum, cerebral

**cernere/cretum** = separate, e.g. discrete, excrete

**cervix/cervicis** = neck (uteri / capitidis), e.g. cervical

**cilium** = eyelid, e.g. supercilious

**cingere/cinctum** = surround, e.g. cincture

**citare/citatum** = rouse, e.g. incite, excite,  
recitation, resuscitation

**claudere/clausum, clus-** = shut, e.g. conclude,  
ex- pre- include, occlusion, claustrophobia

**clavis** = key — collarbone, e.g. clavicle, F, F

**colere/cultum** = till or cultivate (a field)

e.g. agriculture, cult, culture

**columnen/columninis** = column

**coquere/coctum** = cook, e.g. concoct

**copula** = bond, join, e.g. copulate

**cor/cordis** = heart, e.g. cordial

**cornu** = horn, e.g. cornea
